The Prairieland United Way is a locally directed, non-profit organization that is unique because we take a comprehensive, root-cause approach to multi-faceted issues in the Cass, Greene, Morgan, and Scott county areas. We identify and prioritize human needs, make the public aware of these needs, and encourage human service agencies to provide services to help meet these needs.

LOCAL SUPPORT
